


SUTTON IN ASHFIELD AND DISTRICT RAMBLING CLUB Stanage Edge 30th May 2021.

The club is delighted to restart its fortnightly walks programme with a 12-mile circular walk from Hathersage in the Peak District. **There are no facilities on this route so it is important that you bring enough food and drink with you for the day.**



From Hathersage we will climb up onto Higgor Tor where we will take a short break for a snack and a drink.

We will then walk along the top of Higgor Tor to meet the end of Stanage Edge. We will walk along the top of Stanage initially then pick up the path below the edge which will take us to our lunch stop.



After lunch we will cross Bamford Moor and Jarvis Clough before ascending onto Bamford Edge. From Bamford Edge there are magnificent views of the Ladybower Reservoir and Upper Derwent Valley-weather permitting!



From end of Bamford Edge, we follow a minor road for a few 100 metres then a series of footpaths taking us back to Hathersage for around 5.15pm. There should be an opportunity for a pot of tea or a beer in Hathersage before the bus departs at 5.45pm

We are always pleased to welcome new members to the club offering a day of healthy exercise, attractive scenery and friendly company. The Skills coach sets off from the “Staff Of Life” pub in Sutton-in-Ashfield at 9.15am and the Bancroft Lane end of Stockwell Gate (near the Mansfield Asda supermarket) at 9.30am There are other pick-up points between these locations. The coach fare is £10, accompanied juniors free.
